

Verification of Exemption for Disabled Veterans

Under Code of Virginia 58.1-3219.5 to receive Exemption for Disabled Veterans, Veterans or their surviving spouse must file this form with the Commissioner of the Revenue. The veteran shall provide documentation from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs or its successor agency indicating that the veteran has a service-connected, permanent, and total disability. You must also provide a copy of your Drivers License/Photo ID and Utility Bill to prove that the property is utilized as the principal residence for the qualifying veteran or qualifying spouse.

Note: The surviving spouse of a veteran is eligible for the exemption if the death of the veteran occurs on or after January 1, 2011, the surviving spouse does not remarry, and the surviving spouse continues to occupy the real property as his/her principal place of residence.
